



From Our President, Deb Stone The Big Lie



understand, including children and people who may not have liked history before.




The Animal Protection League of Okaloosa County, Inc. is an allvolunteer 501(c) (3) Florida nonprofit corporation chartered in 1981. Animal Protection League offers an affordable Spay & Neuter Program to reduce the growing number of unwanted pets. The program is available to anyone seeking assistance in our area. Due

to financial stressors, sometimes even our low priced spays/neuters are out of reach for some people, so we pick up more of their cost. We believe that spaying and neutering prevents unwanted litters of kittens and puppies, with an end goal of decreasing the numbers of unwanted and euthanized animals. Since 1990, Animal Protection League has sterilized over 26,000 animals. We normally are able to sterilize about 100 animals per month. In 2023, we assisted with 1,802 spay or neuter procedures. Though not our primary mission, we are frequently asked to foster and socialize kittens for adoption. Prior to adoption, kittens receive spay or neuter, vaccinations, flea treatment, blood work/testing, and fecal testing to ensure they are healthy. Adoption fees cover but a fraction of the costs expended to make kittens adoption ready. Animal Protection League is dependent on donations, membership fees, and grants to offset the cost of spay and neuter surgeries. Of every dollar donated to us, 99% goes directly to veterinary care and microchips. The other 1% is used for filing fees with the State of Florida, and minimal administrative supplies/stamps. 
An eligible non-traditional student is classified as:




